Secondary School Grades 8-12

Please ensure that everything is labelled with your child's name, including uniform pieces.

This is a basic list to get students started at this point in the school year. Students should not bring all their supplies to school on the first day. For example, you may need to buy a packet of pencils, but only bring 2 or 3 to school and keep the rest at home. Students should take a pencil case containing basic supplies to every lesson.

- Headphones/earphones for MFL - **not bluetooth enabled**
- Personal sized hand sanitiser
- 1 packet HB lead pencils
- 6 blue or black ballpoint pens
- 3 red pens
- 1 pack of multi-coloured pens (optional)
- 1 package highlighters (variety of colours)
- 1 packet coloured pencils, "24's"
- 1 clear ruler marked in centimetres and inches (30cm/12 ins)
- 1 geometry set
- 2 good quality erasers
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 5 glue sticks
- 1 small durable stapler
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 pencil case/box/space maker
- 1 good quality backpack
- 1 ring binder with 6 different coloured pocket folders to be stored in the binder for loose papers – to be kept in the backpack at all times
- 1 pack loose leaf lined paper (250 sheets)
- 1 pocket English dictionary and thesaurus



ART (Grades 8-12)

- 4B and 6B pencils to last the year
- A mechanical pencil with refills
- 2 black fine tip liners
- 1 packet felt tips
- Multimedia or watercolour sketchbook (*those with spiral rings last longer*). Size: 18 x 24
- 1 pack Air dry clay
- 1 pack coloured pencils (**Same pack from general list can be used. Crayola or Prismacolor is preferred but not required**)
- 1 pack of Cray Pastel (Expressionist oil pastels)
- Acrylic paint set
- Acrylic brushes (flat, round and script)
- Apron
- 2 stretched canvases (basic size 16 x 20)

Music (Grade 8)

Students in Grade 8 may be asked to purchase an instrument mouthpiece. Ms Petersen will organise this in the first semester of 2025/2026 (**Do not purchase ahead of time.**)

IGCSE Sciences Grade 9

- 2 inch Ringbinder folder (only one needed) with a divider

Mathematics Grades 8-10

- 1 calculator Texas Instrument 30XS or the Casio FX-85 series (for grades 6-10)

Mathematics Grades 11 & 12

- Calculator - TI - 84 plus CE
