Other terms will be noted and explained on reports as needed, e.g. for an audited class or grade exemption due to a medical situation.

Promotion and Retention

Students shall normally be promoted when they successfully accomplish the minimum expectations of the course or the grade level in which they are enrolled. In the Secondary School, a grade point average of 2.0 or equivalent, should normally be achieved with a minimum of 80% attendance for promotion to the next year.

Formal Reports

For all Secondary School students, semester reports are issued electronically through ManageBac and the report includes a grade for each academic subject. Mandatory non-graded courses, such as Level Up and Social emotion learning (SEL), will be given a N/A notation on semester reports.
